



INTRODUCING BUS PRIORITY MEASURES ON A3 STAR CORRIDOR AT PURBROOK

This scheme aims to improve bus service journeys and reduce delays on the A3 London Road, increasing reliability on the Horndean to Cosham transit corridor.

What is proposed

- The introduction of new northbound bus gate (bus lane with traffic signals) on the approach to the roundabout, to give priority to buses
- Bus detection technology to allow the buses to bypass traffic queues
- Cycle provision to use bus lane
- Upgrading of hardware/software at the existing southbound bus gate and cycle bypass located approximately 570m to the north of Ladybridge Roundabout

Scheme construction is expected from early 2022 to late spring 2022.
