From 2020-2023, we will deliver the foundation of a rapid transit network within the Portsmouth city region, transforming the experience of travelling by bus and making it the easiest way to travel around our community.

We will:

- Implement quicker and more reliable bus journeys, saving up to 20% on journey times with minimal disruption to car journeys
- Create better access to employment, education and leisure facilities, linking up labour markets to new employment opportunities, and boosting productivity for the city region
- Improve the customer experience, and first mile/last mile connectivity
- Get people to where they need to be on time, every time, increasing the span of operation during the day so buses operate earlier in the morning until later at night, and to more destinations
- Improve air quality
- Improve road safety, particularly for our most vulnerable road users

Funding

The Portsmouth city region was successfully awarded £55.6million from the Department for Transport's Transforming Cities Fund. The funding will support 23 schemes in the area, to improve connectivity with better public transport, walking and cycling links.
